

## Dock Applications

1. Open the box and pull out the light assembly, GFCI plug, 2lb weight, and 2 zipties.
2. Attach 2lb weight to the wire using the zipties.
3. Lower the weight into the water. The bulb unit will follow. Be sure to handle the bulb with caution.
4. Attach photocell to the top of the control box by inserting and twisting clockwise.
5. Plug GFCI plug into an approved GFCI outlet and enjoy!

## Boat Applications

1. Follow steps 1 through 4 from dock application instructions.
2. The 2lb weight can either be attached to the wire, or to the top of the cage, depending on directional illumination preferences.
3. Plug system into a generator or a 1,000 watt inverter.

### Warning!

If for any reason the system should cease to function, disconnect the unit immediately as a safety precaution, then call 855-FISH-LIGHT.

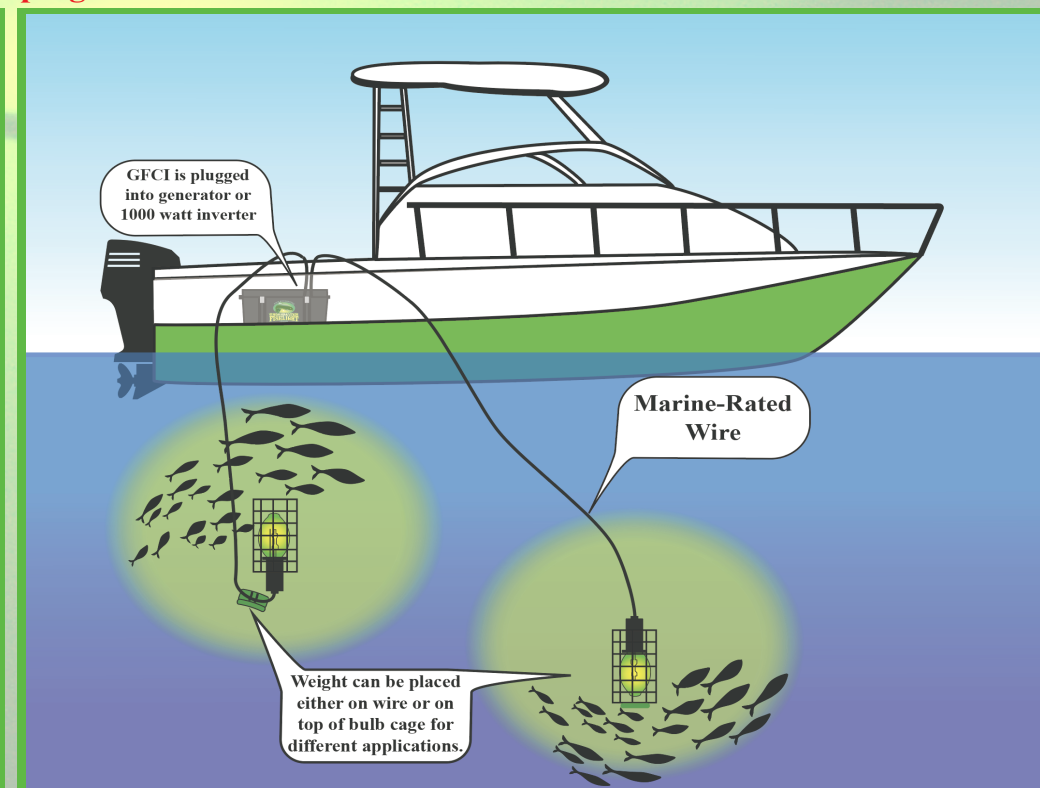
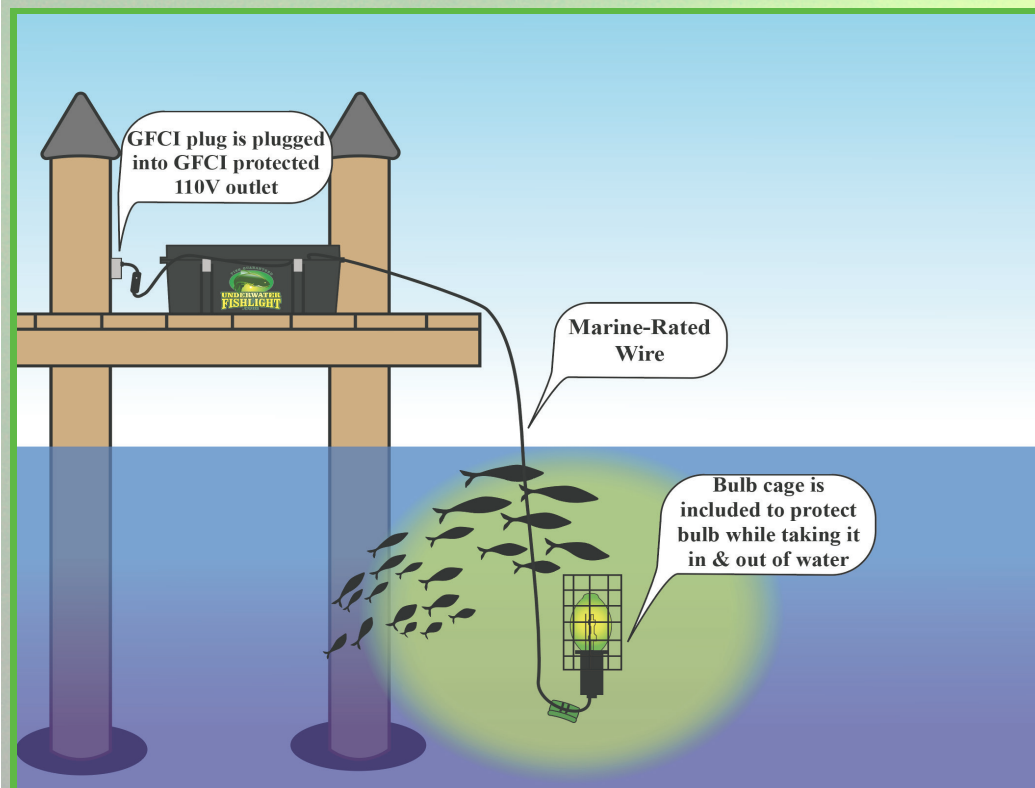
**DO NOT press the reset button on the GFCI plug.**

## Extend the Life of Your System

While in the water, your system should run continuously each night for optimal results and self-cleaning. If taken out of the water, self-cleaning is unnecessary.

The bulbs must never be illuminated out of the water. They run the risk of overheating.

Wire shield is the best way to protect against nicks in the wire caused by fish hooks or other aquatic life. Nicks in the wire are considered damage and not covered under the three-year manufacture warranty. You can purchase wire shield through our website.
